

## GUIDELINES FOR ASSEMBLY AND USE

### WARNING

**HORA DANCING IS AN INHERENTLY DANGEROUS ACTIVITY THAT ENDANGERS PARTICIPANTS, SPECTATORS, AND PROPERTY. BY USING THIS PRODUCT YOU EXPRESSLY ASSUME THE RISK OF INJURY.**

### Assembly Instructions

1. The Hora Chair contains the following components: (i) the chair component, containing a lap restraint device and two (2) cylindrical tubes measuring {1-5/8 inches x 14 inches} attached to the base of the seat plate called side pipe receivers; (ii) two (2) side pipes, each measuring {1-1/2 inches x 7 feet}; and (iii) two (2) cotter pins, each measuring {3 inches}.
2. Before and after each assembly, carefully inspect the structural integrity of The Hora Chair and its components, including but not limited to the lap restraint device and each of the weld points, side pipe receivers, side pipes and cotter pins. Do NOT use The Hora Chair if any component is missing, displays signs of stress, or otherwise does not appear to be in proper functioning condition.
3. Assemble The Hora Chair properly. A side pipe should be inserted into each side of The Hora Chair. Assemble by first placing the chair firmly on all 4 legs on level ground. Place a side pipe into the appropriate side pipe receiver such that the {1/4} inch holes drilled in each of the side pipes and side pipe receivers are aligned. Once the side pipes have been inserted into and aligned with the side pipe receivers, slide the cotter pin through each of the {1/4} inch holes. The cotter pins should slide through the holes drilled in each of the side pipes and side pipe receivers such that cotter pin passes completely through the side pipe receiver. After inserting each cotter pin, the side pipe should be tested to ensure proper assembly. If the side pipe can be removed, the chair has not been properly assembled because either the cotter pin was not properly installed, the side pipe was not inserted correctly, or the 1/4 inch holes drilled into the side pipe and side pipe receiver were not properly aligned. Do NOT use The Hora Chair if either side pipe can be removed. After completing the assembly of the first side of the Hora Chair, repeat the above steps for the second side.
4. After completing assembly of The Hora Chair, again confirm proper assembly and functioning condition, including but not limited to checking that the lap restraint device is properly functioning and that the side pipes are securely fastened to The Hora Chair.

### Use Instructions

5. To use The Hora Chair, the chair passenger should be seated in The Hora Chair while The Hora Chair remains sitting on stable, level ground. The passenger should be seated and secured into the chair by connecting the "male" and "female" ends of the lap restraint device together; the lap restraint device should make an audible "click," which indicates that the device is properly fastened. The lap restraint device should be tested by applying pressure to the belt to ensure it has been securely fastened.
6. No less than six (6) persons are needed to assist in properly lifting The Hora Chair. Each of the six (6) "lifters" should be: (i) 18 years or older; (ii) able to comfortably lift in excess of 50 lbs above his/her heads; (iii) of capable, competent, and mature mind and body; and (iv) not under the influence of alcohol or drugs. There should be at least one (1) lifter at each end, and at least two (2) lifters on each side. The lifters on the sides should be placed in such a way that one (1) lifter is in front of the chair and one (1) lifter is behind the chair. Lifters and passengers should be mindful that hora dancing activities are inherently dangerous and that zealous and abrupt shifting of the Hora Chair threatens the passenger, lifters, spectators and property. Lifters should ensure there is adequate room for lifting and that crowds do not jeopardize stability.
7. Upon completion of hora dance activities, lifters should place The Hora Chair and its passenger gently on stable, level ground. Once seated on stable, level ground, the passenger may unfasten the lap restraint device.
8. The Hora Chair, LLC recommends applying Scotchgard-TM or other similar products to the seat to protect it from damage and ensure longevity.
